SAINIK SCHOOLS SOCIETY

Memorandum of Association of the Sainik Schools Society.

1. The name of the Society is "Sainik Schools Society" (hereinafter referred to as the "Society").
2. The registered office of the Society is situated at Central Secretariat Building (Room No. 137, South Block), in the Union Territory of Delhi.
3. The object for which the Society is established are :-
 - (i) to establish Sainik Schools in various parts of India, providing special school education of a high standard with the aim of preparing boys academically and physically for entry into the National Defence Academy and other walks of life;
 - (ii) to take steps which may be necessary or expedient for the management and administration of the Schools;
 - (iii) to prescribe general educational and administrative policy pertaining to the Schools;
 - (iv) to purchase, take on lease, accept as a gift or otherwise acquire any land or building wherever situated in India which may be necessary or convenient for the Society;
 - (v) to construct or alter any building which may be necessary for the Society;
 - (vi) to sell, lease, exchange and otherwise transfer all or any portion of the properties of the Society;
 - (vii) to obtain grants from States or Central Government or raise funds from other sources for promotion of such Sainik Schools;
 - (viii) to make, adopt and vary from time to time, rules for conducting the business of the Society and administration of the Schools;

(ix) for the purposes of the Society to draw and accept and make and endorse, discount and negotiate Government of India and other promissory notes, bills of exchange, cheques or other negotiable instruments;

(x) to invest the funds of, or money entrusted to the Society upon such securities or in such manner as may from time to time be determined by the Board of Governors and from time to time to sell or transpose such investment;

(xi) to do all other such things as the Society may consider necessary, incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects,
