REOPENING OF SCHOOL AFTER SUMMER VACATION

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Greetings from Sainik School Ghorakhal.

1. The school shall reopen after the Summer Vacation on 26 June 2026. All cadets are required to report to the school campus on 26 June 2026 positively by 1700 hrs (05:00 PM).
2. **Reporting of Cadets**
 - (a) All cadets must report to the school by 1700 hrs on 26 June 2026.
 - (b) Cadets reporting after the stipulated time shall be liable to pay Late Reporting Fine as per school rules:
 - (i) ₹500/- per day for the first three days of delay.
 - (ii) ₹1,000/- per day thereafter.
 - (c) Late reporting may also result in academic loss, disciplinary action, and absence from classes, for which parents shall be responsible.
3. **School Fee**
 - (a) Parents are requested to ensure that all school dues are cleared before the reopening of school.
 - (b) Cadets whose fee remains unpaid beyond the prescribed date will not be permitted to join the school until all dues are cleared.
 - (c) Late fee charges shall be levied as per existing school rules. Parents are requested to adhere circular No. 3 dated 09 Jun 2026 circulated in Parents whatsapp class group.
 - (d) Parents are advised to retain proof of fee payment and produce the same in case your wards name is being reflected in the defaulters list.
4. **School rules and directions to be followed:-**
 - (a) Mobile phones, smart watches, electric & electronic gadgets are strictly banned in the school premises and is not to be carried by the cadets. In case found in possession of any such item, fine/ disciplinary action will be levied/ initiated.
 - (b) No medicines are to be carried by any cadet in the school. In case, due to any illness there are medicines prescribed by a doctor, the same needs to be handed over to the School Doctor/ Nursing Sister along with the prescription. The cadet will be taking the medicines under supervision of the Doctor/ Nursing Sister. Parents shall inform the school in writing about any significant medical condition, allergy or medication being taken by the cadet. Medicines, if required, must be properly labeled and handed over as per school procedures.
 - (c) All cadets to bring Swimming Costumes, Goggles and Swimming Cap mandatorily. Also, adequate moisturizer needs to be carried by each cadet for applying after swimming.
 - (d) Cadets to report to school with proper hair cut as prescribed by school. Growing beard in school is prohibited.
 - (e) Parents are requested not to hand over any cash to their wards.
 - (f) The luggage of all cadets will be thoroughly checked upon at the main gate during arrival.
 - (g) Parents and cadets must ensure that no prohibited or unauthorized items are brought to the school.

(h) Cadets must report in proper school uniform and with all authorized clothing and personal kit items.

5. **Vehicle Parking**

(a) Vehicle parking shall be permitted only in Maj CS Misra ground. Parents are requested not to park their vehicles on the main road of the school.

(b) Parents who find difficulty in parking their vehicles at Maj CS Misra ground, have to park their vehicles on the main road at Golu Devta temple road outside the school premises at their own risk.

(c) Parking on School Main road or any other area except Maj CS Misra ground is strictly prohibited.

6. **Entry of Parents**

(a) Parents/Guardians shall not be allowed to proceed/ enter towards the hostel area or cadets' houses.

(b) Parents are requested to cooperate with the security staff and follow all directions issued on the day of reporting.

7. **Reporting Day Arrangements**

(a) Adequate arrangements have been made by the school for the reception and reporting of cadets.

(b) Drinking water and other essential facilities shall be available at designated locations.

(c) All cadets will undergo mandatory luggage checking at the time of reporting.

(d) Cadets shall proceed to their respective Houses/Hostels only after completion of luggage checking and reporting formalities.

(e) Parents are requested to cooperate with school staff and security personnel for smooth conduct of reporting procedures.

8. **Luggage and Personal Belongings**

(a) Unauthorized items found during checking shall be confiscated and disciplinary action may be initiated.

9. **Uniform, Haircut and Personal Turnout**

(a) Cadets must maintain prescribed grooming standards.

(b) Mandatory haircut inspection shall be conducted on reopening.

10. **Academic Preparation**

(a) Cadets must complete all holiday assignments, projects and other work assigned during the Summer Vacation.

(b) Cadets should report with all prescribed textbooks, notebooks and study material.

11. **Parent-School Communication**

(a) Parents of classes VI to XII are requested to attend Parent-Teacher Meetings (PTMs) regularly.

(b) Parents are advised to regularly check the School Diary, School Website and official communication channels of the school to keep themselves updated on school's activities as all important information regarding examinations, activities, holidays, fee schedules and administrative instructions are communicated through these platforms.

12. **Discipline and Conduct**
 (a) Cadets are expected to maintain the highest standards of discipline, punctuality and conduct. Parents are requested to counsel their wards accordingly and ask them not to get into any indisciplinary acts.
 (b) Any violation of school rules shall attract disciplinary action as deemed appropriate by the school authorities. The school follows "**Zero Tolerance**" Policy on disciplinary issues.
13. **Cash and Valuables**
 (a) Parents are advised not to handover any cash, jewellery, expensive watches or any other valuables to their wards.
Note: Such items become lucrative and may become objects of attraction and distraction for other cadets leading to avoidable comparisons among them as our cadets come from varied socio-economic backgrounds, parents are requested not to provide such over expensive items to their wards.
 (b) The school shall not be responsible for loss, theft, damage or misplacement of cash, valuables or unauthorized items brought by cadets.

REMINDER

- (a) All cadets must report to the school **on 26 June 2026 by 1700 hrs.**
 (b) Parents are requested to ensure timely reporting of their ward, clearance of all outstanding fees, completion of holiday assignments and compliance with school regulations regarding prohibited items.
15. Once again, I request for your continued cooperation and active participation which is essential for the holistic development and success of your ward.
